ORDER:

In the reference 5th read above, the Administrative Officer, Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (TAFRC), Hyderabad has informed that the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee(TAFRC) meeting held on 29.10.2025 and recommended the tuition fee fixed for the LLM/ML(2 years) courses offered by the Private Unaided Profession Institutions for issuance of the Government Orders for the Block period 2025-28. The fee fixed tuition fee does not include the special fee and admission fee.

2. Government after careful examination have decided to accept the recommendations of the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee(TAFRC) and the following Notification shall be published in the issue of the Telangana State Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule-8 of the Telangana Law Courses (Regulation of Admissions into Post Graduate Law LLM/ML Course through Common Entrance Test Rules, 2006 read with sub-rule (V) of Rule-4 of the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee for Professional courses offered in Private Un-aided (Minority/Non-Minority) Professional Institutions Rules, 2006 issued in the G.O 1st read above and adopted vide G.O 3rd read above, and in pursuance of the resolution of the Committee (TAFRC) dated:29.10.2025 received in the reference 5th read above, the Governor of Telangana hereby notify the uniform fee structure for Post Graduate Law LLM/ML courses in Private Un-aided Professional Colleges in the State of Telangana for the Academic Years 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28, as follows:-

3. Consequently Government hereby issues the following directions to all the concerned Private LLM/ML colleges:

- (i) The students admitted to the course during the academic year 2025-26 shall continue to pay every year the same annual tuition fee as paid at the time of their admission till they complete the course.
- (ii) The students who were admitted in the college prior to the academic year 2025-26 shall continue to pay every year the same annual tuition fee at the rate existing at the time of their admission till they complete the course,
- (iii) The institution shall collect the tuition fee every year in advance only for that particular year either in a lump sum or in installments, if it so opts.
- (iv) The Institutions shall not charge any capitation fee or any amount unauthorizedly or illegally under any other head or guise (e.g., donation etc.), either directly or indirectly, other than the fee fixed by the Committee, as collection of any such unauthorized amounts would amount to charging of Capitation Fee, and that the surplus (profit) that is generated from the collection of the Fee must be for the benefit of the Institution, and cannot be diverted for other purposes or for personal gain.
- (v) The Institutions are informed that fixation of the Fee Structure by the Admission & Fee Regulation Committee will not by itself enable or permit the managements to run the relevant courses in their institutions, if they are otherwise not duly recognized and permitted by the Government or BCI / UGC / Concerned University / Government Department at any relevant time.
- (vi) The enhanced fee now being in respect of institutions whose proposals have been evaluated based on the details / figures furnished by them to TAFRC 1s subject to further physical verification, if it is found that the data given by the institution is not correct, the Fee shall be subject to change at a later date and this fact shall be informed to the University or Competent Authority concerned for taking necessary action in accordance with law.

(vii) The institutions for whom tuition fee is not fixed shall not be entitled to collect any tuition fee during the block period 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28-

(viii) The above Tuition fee is fixed for the academic years 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28 subject to provision for neutralization of inflationary impact to the required extent at the beginning of the academic year 2025-26.


